Tri-Fraternity Benefit Concert for Diana Jones

In honor of fellow music major, Diana Jones, the Alpha Zeta chapter, along with the RU chapters of Sigma Alpha lota and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, organized a benefit concert and fundraiser in which all of the proceeds went to

Diana in order to help defer the costs of her medical care. Diana was recently diagnosed with a lesion on the left hemisphere of her brain and is in desperate need of surgery to remove it. If it is left untreated she will slowly begin to lose motor function and there is also a high risk of paralysis to the right side of her body. The AZ chapter was approached by members of PMA to help organize and participate in a benefit concert in conjunction with their chapter and with our RU Sigma Alpha lota chapter, in which 100% of the proceeds would go directly to Diana to help offset the costs of some of her medical expenses.

On April 24, 2016 the three RU music fraternities were joined together in support of Diana and gave an incredibly moving performance. Each chapter performed individual pieces specific to each group but there were also several tri-fraternity ensembles that included brass quintets, jazz ensembles, and a large tri-fraternity choir performance of the popular song Hallelujah written by Leonard Cohen. After the performance we held a bake sale, raffle drawing, and our spring candidates even set up their candidate service project to show their support as well!



We were so fortunate that Diana was able to be at the performance and we were able to raise close to \$500, all of which will go directly to Diana!!!

The Alpha Zeta chapter was incredibly honored to have been able to participate in this wonderful service opportunity and we are even more excited that we were able to use music to serve our fellow student's needs. We would also like to extend a special thank you to our fellow music fraternities on the RU campus, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and Sigma Alpha lota, for making such great music with us!

We are happy to report that Diana has found a surgeon who is able to perform the procedure and her medical expenses are very close to being completely covered! Mu Phi Epsilon Does Sole Hope!

On April 23, 2016 the Alpha Zeta chapter once again held a Sole Hope shoe cutting party! Sole Hope is an organization that specializes in making shoes out of denim for children in Africa. These children are constantly under threat of "jiggers" digging into their feet. Jiggers are tiny bugs that burrow into the feet and lay eggs, which hatch and cause even more damage; the only way to remove the jiggers is to dig them out with a sharp object. Sole Hope shoe cutting parties provide the materials to make the shoes and they are then sent to Africa where they are used to create jobs for the locals who use the materials to assemble the shoes.

At our shoe cutting party we spent some much needed Phamily time with one another and also cut patterns for over 50 pairs of shoes! This has proved to be one of our most enjoyable and successful service projects and we hope to continue it in the future!
